

## VPN Connection from Windows Vista to Linux Server (no encryption)

- Click "Start", "Control Panel", "Network and Sharing Center"
- Under Tasks, click on "Set up a connection or network"
- Click on "Connect to workplace", then click "Next".
- Select "Use my Internet Connection (VPN)"

Note: if you previously setup a connection, it will show a different screen.

In this case select "No, create a new connection".

- Fill in your internet address (IP address or DNS Name as provided by NetSol)
- Under "Destination Name" you can enter anything like e.g. Office VPN
- In next screen, fill in Username and Password as provided and click "Create"
- Click "Close"

- Under Tasks, select "Manage network connections"
- Right-click on the newly created VPN Connection and then on "Properties"
- **Click the "Security Tab" and uncheck "Require data encryption"**
- Click on the "Networking" Tab
- Highlight "Internet Protocol Version 4" and click "Properties"
- Click "Advanced" and uncheck "Use default gateway on remote network"
- Click "OK", "OK", "OK"
